PANARAMIC SMILE stalked the pace, made a bid three wide in the second turn, vied three wide, rallied and drew clear in the third turn and drew off. IRISH BEST stalked the pace on the rail, ran evenly, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide and finished second best. EPIC ADVENTURE was taken back early on the rail, ran evenly, gained in the third turn, rallied but faltered. RITZY MON bore out entering the first turn, raced three wide, bid three wide into the second turn, vied four wide in the backstretch but weakened after the quarter pole and chased the lead. CIMMARON SKY was off slowly, ran unevenly from between rivals, rallied into the stretch but faded. CHEROKEE R N was unruly from the start, bore out sharply in the turns and was never a factor. LAINE AND CHASE dueled on the rail early, bid and vied on the rail in the second turn but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. BELLY TAP dueled early, bid and vied four wide in the second turn, weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
