FIRST PLACE LADY raced five wide into the first turn, ran evenly, gained steadily, made a bid at the quarter pole, led into the stretch. CLEVER CITY dueled to the outside, weakened st mid stretch and held place. KESTNER raced three wide into the first turn, ran evenly, rallied three wide and finished well. WEEKEND TRADE lacked early speed, raced evenly, rallied four wide and finished well. SECOND NOTIS raced three wide early, contended evenly but faded in the stretch. ESTEEMS SQUAD raced four wide into the first turn, dropped back to trail. CRYSTAL HILL stalked the pace on the rail, weakened in the second turn and dropped back. ATLANTIC SUMMER saved ground, dueled, but weakened in the second turn and trailed.
