BOBBY HANDY broke well, set the pace, edged ahead in the backstretch and drew clear. MAJOR TEMPER saved ground, ran evenly, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied into the stretch and finished second best. BEAR FAMOUS TRIP broke well, stalked evenly, weakened in the backstretch and faded. CONSTABLE SHEPPARD lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. FIRST FIRE lacked speed, trailed and passed tiring rivals. RELATORRE stalked to the outside, weakened in the backstretch, chased and gave way. BENT TUNE was caught in tight early and was taken back, raced to the outside, gave way in the third turn and trailed.
