UP JUMPS A MONSTER raced wide, ran evenly, closed steadily in the third turn, rallied three wide and closed steadily. TOCCTIVE trailed early, raced evenly, gained steadily in the the third turn, rallied four wide and closed. CLEAR THE RUNWAY dueled to the outside, weakened in the third turn and held well late. DOUGS BUDDY saved ground, dueled, weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. AMPSTERBAND raced wide early, stalked the pace but weakened in the third turn and dropped back. CAFEINE COWBOY raced wide early, stalked the pace on the rail, weakened near the quarter pole and dropped back.
