WHAT'S UP DOC raced evenly to the outside, gained in the second turn, led in the upper stretch and drthe r. SKID lacked speed, gained ground in the second turn, got through in the upper stretch and finished well. SALTON CHIEF dueled to the outside, led in the backstretch, weakened after the quarter pole and faded. CASANOVA KING LACKED EARLY speed, drifted entering the first turn, raced evenly, rallied five wide and gained ground. YIPPY KIA YEAH was slow early, raced evenly on the rail, but flattened out in the stretch. GRAN KASEKI raced evenly to the outside and showed a mild rally. WANDOFUL dueled on the rail, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back steadily. CRUZENFORCHICKS broke sharply and contended, raced evenly and dropped back in the second turn. SLASH raced three wide in the first turn, stalked the pace but gave way in the second turn.
