HUGO TOO SLOW squeezed out at start, lost ground in the first turn and tired. BEST SHAKIN had a good start, stalked the front horses, weakened in the last turn and faded. GORDIE THE WELDER went wide early, chased through out and did not gain. MADISEN'S FORTUNE followed the whole race and had no rally. LA BEAUA squeezed at the start, was taken back and trailed.
