ECTON'S GEM was unhurried early, advanced steadily, rallied four wide, closed steadily to get up late. FREUD'S CURE saved ground, raced evenly, gained in the second turn, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, led late but was outfinished. BLING saved ground, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and closed fast late. SUMMER SENSATION set a pressured pace, rallied in the upper stretch but weakened in mid stretch. SMOKEM NINETY-NINE pressed the pace to the outside but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. CATALONE lacked speed, trailed, advanced steadily, rallied into the stretch and finished well. IT'S NOT OVER YET raced evenly to the outside, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. KNIGHT'S COVENANT stalked the lead on the rail, dropped back in the second turn, gave way and was eased.
