Footnotes

TY'S BROOKE vied three wide, led in the upper stretch, drifted slightly, rallied and held on late. HOLY TEMPEST lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied three wide, closed fast and just missed. QUALITY TOCS broke well, vied on the rail, weakened at the quarter pole but held place. FIRE UNDER ICE raced wide early, dropped back in the backstretch. T AND T'S JET saved ground, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. SCOOT FOR LOOT vied from between rivals, weakened after the quarter pole and faded. MY WICKED PLEASURE raced between rivals early, dropped back in the backstretch. MOUNTAIN PARK stalked the pace on the rail rallied three wide and gave way.
