SILVERMAN saved ground, dueled in the backstretch with BAM BAM and prevailed in a long drive. BAM BAM dueled to the outside of SILVERMAN and was outfinished in a long drive. TWO MANY DOTS was four wide in the first turn, was taken back then gained ground along backstretch and chased the leaders. BUBBA SLY was three wide in the first turn, dropped back, saved ground and finished evenly. HOMECOMING MISS was five wide in the first turn, dropped back, raced evenly from three and weakened. IRENE'S SERENADE was slow early, drifted out in the first turn, saved ground, and was no threat. FOLLOW THE RIVER was four wide in the first turn, dropped back, raced evenly, weakened in the second turn and tired.
