MAD WIN chased the leaders on the rail, gained ground steadily, rallied into the stretch, closed and led in mid stretch. BOULDER HAT was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide and closed fast for place. FREEQUARTERSMINE pressed the pace to the outside, led in the upper stretch but weakened in mid stretch. NELLIE'S GENIUS saved ground, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch, slipped by rivals and finished well. GREENWOOD MEADOW raced to the outside, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied into the upper stretch but faded late. WHAT THE DEVIL chased the leaders to the outside, dropped back in the second turn, rallied three wide and gained late. PUERTO MONTT set a pressured pace on the rail, weakened in the upper stretch and faded. KING KWAI was slow early, saved ground, gained in the second turn, rallied five wide but was no threat. ELM CREEK lacked speed, trailed.
