TO DREAM AGAIN gaining backstretch, rallied, got through stretch, closed fast. CROSSING pressed pace, outside, drew clear 2nd turn, weakened late. LOT A SMOKE rail, chased, evenly. TAMMIE'S TUNE slow early, steady advance, rallied 3 wide upper stretch, gaining. JESSIE GUEST rail, evenly, gaining, mild rally upper stretch, gaining. VOLUNTEER ANNIE 3 wide first turn, evenly, no rally, faded stretch. REAL STERLING shuffled back start, saved ground, no factor. CENTURY MARK rail, set pressured pace, weakened backstretch, dropped back. WILDLY RUTH rail, chased, dropped back backstretch.
