Footnotes

MILLWRIGHT dueled on the rail, headed in the second turn, rallied and drew clear in mid stretch. MOSSBANK vied for the early lead, made a bid three wide in the backstretch, opened a short lead in the second turn, rallied into the stretch but faded. VISION OF ROSES raced three wide, bid three wide in the backstretch, rallied three wide to get up for third. CANDLESTICK JACK stalked the pace on the rail, ran evenly, gained ground on the rail in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and closed. RUNNING IRON dueled to the outside, weakened in the backstretch and faded. LINDSEY'S STORM lacked early speed, raced to the outside, rallied four wide into the stretch but flattened out. PLAGIARIST was slow early, saved ground and was never a factor. PROJECT FIFTY FIVE raced five wide early, bid five wide in the backstretch but weakened in the second turn.
