Footnotes

BARFLY'S SURVIVOR dueled early on the rail, dropped back to stalk in the backstretch, made a bid, drew clear and held on. DOUBLE KISSES was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground steadily, got through along the rail and closed. TRIAL BY PEERS saved ground, raced evenly, gained in the third turn, rallied but weakened in the stretch. BRAD'S BROTHER stalked on the rail, bid in the second turn, led in the backstretch but weakened in the third turn. REBEL THE RED contended evenly on the rail, gained ground in the third turn but flattened out. IMAGE EXPRESS dueled to the outside, opened a led in the backstretch but weakened in the third turn and tired. SCAT MAN SCURRY raced three wide early, ran evenly, showed a mild rally but dropped back. ETESIAN raced five wide early, dropped back, raced evenly and was no factor. BANDITO BAR NONE raced four wide early and dropped back.
