NOTIS THE CRIME was taken back, raced evenly, gained ground steadily, rallied, and closed steadily to get up late. GRANITE POINT set the pace, raced evenly but weakened in mid stretch. TOY TIGER raced evenly on the rail, made a in the third turn but flattened out .BILLYREA chased the lead on the rail, gained ground in the backstretch, was caught in tight on the rail late in the third turn and showed a mild bid. AFRICAN LAD saved ground ground, chased the early pace early, ran evenly but weakened in the third turn and gave way. VELVET FIRE lacked early speed, raced on the rail and showed showed little. PALM DRIVE broke in the air, trailed and was never a factor. ROWDY RENEGADE was slow early, gained ground along the rail entered the stretch three wide and finished evenly.ALITRAP stalked the pace to the outside, weakened after the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch .The rider on BILLYREA claimed foul on GRANITE POINT for interference late in the third turn..The claim of foul was not allowed.
