**Footnotes**

SIN TORO lacked early speed, gained along the rail, rallied four wide into the stretch and closed fast to get up late. KATAKING rushed to the lead, dueled on the rail, opened a lead in the third turn but weakened late and held place. EXCURSION stalked the pace to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide but was outfinished. PLAIN JAMES dueled to the outside but weakened after the quarter pole, and faded in the stretch. BAND OF THUNDER was taken back early, raced evenly on the, rallied five wide into the stretch and finished well. HAWKERS GATE was taken back early, raced evenly then gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide and finished evenly. FREUD'S CURE stalked the pace evenly along the rail then rallied into the upper stretch but flattened out. MIDNIGHT WISH raced three wide early and was taken back to race evenly and was no factor. CIELO'S LAD lacked speed and was carried out entering the first turn and was no factor. HENRY D. was slow early, drifted out entering the first turn, dropped back and trailed.
