CATORCE DE LA FAMA (CHI) raced between rivals, set the pace, drew clear in the backstretch and held well. TAYLOR'S TALE raced evenly, gained ground in the backstretch but flattened out. TOP BREW lacked early speed raced evenly, gained ground in the in the third turn and finished evenly. HARLEM lacked early speed, saved ground, gained in the backstretch but weakened in the stretch. NEECHI'S REGAL SON stalked the pace on the rail, ran evenly but weakened in the third turn but faded. JUST CALL ME DUKE lacked early speed, saved ground then gained ground in the third turn but flattened out. AYE AYE SIR stalked the pace on the rail but weakened in the third turn and faded. DOCTOR LENNY contended to the outside but, weakened in the backstretch and gave way. DRIFTIN COWBOY saved ground, raced evenly but weakened. POLAR lacked speed, gave way and trailed.
