IT'S GOOD TO BE ME broke sharply to set the pace, rallied in the upper stretch and drew clear. TOBY BAY gained ground steadily on the rail, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, rallied and finished well. TESTY HUSSY broke sharply, raced close up on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch but flattened out. THAT'S A GOOD BOY stalked the pace to the outside, raced evenly but weakened in the backstretch and faded in the stretch. WILD INTENT stalked the pace on the rail but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. NECHAKO lacked speed, trailed and was never a factor. WOOD B NICE lacked speed, raced to the outside and dropped back steadily.
