### Footnotes

MY LUCKY THIRTEEN stalked three wide, bid three wide in the backstretch, dueled in the third turn, opened a lead into the stretch and held well. MR. SHADAR chased the lead on the rail, gained ground in the third turn, rallied four wide and closed. COOL DIABLO was unhurried early, raced evenly, gained ground in the third turn and rallied for a late gain. INUIT FISHER pressed the pace to the outside, made a bid in the third turn, dueled but weakened then faded in the stretch. ROAD TALK set a pressured pace on the rail, weakened in the third turn and dropped back.
