**Footnotes**

TEJANO TROUBLE stalked the early pace from three wide, made a bid entering the second turn, dueled to the outside of ST REGS (IRE), led after the quarter pole and drew clear. ST REGS (IRE) set the pace on the rail, dueled to the inside of TEJANO TROUBLE in the second turn but weakened at the quarter pole and finished second best. CANDID REMARK stalked the early pace, raced evenly, weakened in the third turn and finished evenly. BAD HAT saved ground, raced evenly while close up, entered the stretch three wide and flattened out. BEAU BRASS lacked early speed, trailed and was no factor. HOT WIRED saved ground, stalked the pace, raced evenly but faded.
