Footnotes

BIG O PUCK STOPPER saved ground, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied into the upper stretch and closed steadily. SIX PACK broke inward and bumped, dueled to the outside, rallied into the stretch, led late but weakened. GRAN KASEKI was brushed and shuffled back on the rail, raced evenly, rallied into the stretch and gained ground. MY FRIEND TOM 4 raced wide early, saved ground in the backstretch, gained in the second turn but flattened out. BANG UP BERNIE was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace on the rail but weakened in the upper stretch. SUNNY BREAK broke inward and bumped with SIX PACK, vied three wide early but weakened in the second turn and faded. SIR BOBBSY lacked early speed, raced evenly and was never a factor. R J'S GIFT raced three wide into the first turn, dropped back and trailed.
