YANKEE COLONEL was caught three wide early, raced to the outside, bid three wide into the second turn, dueled in the stretch and prevailed. JUDGE BREW stalked the pace on the rail, made a bid in the second turn, dueled in the stretch and was outfinished. GO RACY lacked speed, gained ground along the outside, rallied four wide and finished well. FINTAN saved ground, raced evenly then rallied four wide and finished evenly. SKIMATIC saved ground, raced evenly, weakened in the second turn and entered the stretch three wide. UNCLERICHPEANUTS was three wide early, raced evenly and was no factor. SCRIPTOCAT set a pressured pace on the rail but weakened in the second turn and dropped back. BUTTONS N SMILES pressed the pace to the outside, made a bid in the backstretch but gave way.
