Footnotes

SALT FLAT SPEED broke sharply to set the pace, drew clear in the second turn and drew off in the stretch. POWER SHIFT raced three wide early, gained ground from three wide, rally three wide into the stretch and closed steadily on place. JACK'S KID stalked the pace from three wide but weakened in the second turn and flattened out in the stretch. LAUROYLYMPIO stalked the pace on the rail but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. PART PIRATE stalked the lead from between horses but weakened at the quarter pole and dropped back in the stretch. BLACKCOMB RUN was slow early, raced evenly on the rail and was never a no factor. AIRO FAITH drifted out entering the first turn, moved to the rail, raced evenly and was no threat. DUAL FUEL lacked speed, trailed, showed little.
