**Footnotes**

ESKIMO PRIDE raced close up on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch and closed well in the stretch. SUPPOSE A ROSE set the pace, rallied in mid stretch but weakened late. BIG APPLE RED saved ground, raced evenly, rallied three wide and finished well. SARCEE raced close up from three wide, ran evenly and made a mild bid. CHINA DOLL raced evenly to the outside, and showed a mild rally. THIS B JEWEL lacked speed and trailed. SAM'S A GIRL stalked the pace but weakened in the second turn, entered the stretch three wide and faded.
