BIG BAD BUTCH pressed the pace three wide, drew clear in the second turn and drew off in the stretch. VICTOR MAN lacked speed, raced to the outside, gained in the second turn, rallied three wide and finished second best. VICAR'S ICE PICK broke sharply, saved ground, stalked the pace, rallied three wide and finished evenly. DAKOBRA broke sharply along the rail but was unruly throughout and dropped back in the second turn. TULLY B dueled on the rail, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back in the second turn. BIG STEVEN broke outward then angled in sharply, trailed and passed tiring rivals. OUR BOY LOUIE was slow early, raced to the outside and showed little. HAWAIIAN FEVER dueled to the outside, weakened in the second turn and dropped back.
