INUIT FISHER stalked the pace on the rail, closed in the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn, led at the quarter /4 pole, rallied and held well late. BAD BIG AL raced evenly to the outside, made a bid three wide entering the second turn, rallied three wide but failed to gain ground and finished second best. COOL SYNSTATION set the pace but weakened approaching the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. JASPER'S VALENTINE raced evenly on the rail, gained in the backstretch and showed a mild rally. DIAMOND DOC raced evenly to the outside, rallied three wide and finished evenly. CASEY'S ON CALL lacked speed, trailed and was never a threat. FOOTPRINT saved ground, raced evenly, failed to rally and flattened out.
