TEMPERED SAPHIRE was unhurried early, raced evenly on the rail, made a bid in the backstretch, dueled in the third turn, rallied and held on late. MADEIRA PARK lacked early speed, raced evenly, closed in the third turn, altered course inside in the stretch and closed well. PLETHORA dueled on the rail, led and dueled in the third turn but weakened in mid stretch. SWEET LAURETTE stalked evenly on the rail msde a bid in the third third turn but weakened. BLUE BABY broke well, stalked the pace but faded in the stretch. PUMPKIN HOLLOW dueled to the outside, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. SUGARSCAT trailed and was factor. FOLLY WITH MOLLY lacked speed and trailed late
