COUNTRY BUTTON dueled to the outside, opened a lead after the quarter pole and drew clear in the stretch. LEPRECHAUN KID raced three wide into the first turn, ran evenly on the rail, rallied, came in mid stretch and bumped. ZIPPY REQUEST raced four wide in the first turn, chased the lead in the backstretch and made a mild bid from three wide. QUINNZ AWAY ran off pre race, lacked speed, raced evenly and was no factor. TULAMEEN KAT was caught five wide in the first turn, dropped back and was no factor. DEPUTY LASS dueled on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole but was bumped along the rail in mid stretch. ABALOS angled out at the start, dropped back and was eased
