Footnotes

CHIEF'S MAGIC dueled to the outside, assumed command in the second turn, rallied and drew clear in the stretch. JUAN MIGHT stalked the pace from between rivals, faded in the second turn and held place. STEPHANSON dueled on the rail, weakened late in the backstretch, showed a mild rally and finished evenly. WIRED TWO TWENTY stalked the pace three wide, raced evenly, rallied three wide and finished evenly. YANKEE COLONEL raced three wide into the first turn, dropped back and trailed. CANDLESTICK JACK stalked the pace on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and finished evenly.
