ROYAL BUTTONS vied for the lead from between rivals, rallied into the upper stretch, led late and held well. RUNAWAY RUUDY vied for the lead from three wide, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished. CANDYLANE vied for the lead on the rail but weakened after the quarter pole and finished evenly. EASY WHISKEY vied for the lead from four wide but weakened after the quarter pole and ran evenly in the stretch. SMITTY'S FUN saved ground, raced evenly then rallied four wide into the stretch and gained ground. SUE THE TIGER lacked speed, was carried out in the turn and was never a threat. DRIVE THRU lacked speed, saved ground rail, drifted out in the turn and was no factor.
