JUST THE CASH was never far back while racing along the rail, angled out four wide into the lane, responded when asked and won driving. BUD TIME raced four wide on the first and second turns while being unhurried, swung five wide on the final bend and into the lane and showed a good late rally. CAPTAIN'S MELODY was rushed to contention, pressed the pace while racing two wide and weakened late. A BOY FOR ANGIE was void of early foot and found his best stride late along the inside. SHADY MOOSE stalked the pace while racing three wide and lacked a late response. VICTOR MAN was away alertly, set the pace along the rail and tired after six furlongs. THE BARTON BOY, off a step slow, was allowed out settle into stride while racing outside a rival and tired on the final turn. NOTIS THE CRIME trailed throughout.
