VISION OF ROSES stalked the pace to the outside, made a mild bid at the quarter pole, dueled and drew clear in the second turn. EXPLORATION raced evenly, gained in the second turn, rallied three wide and gained. RUNNING IRON broke sharply, set a pressured pace, dueled at the quarter pole but flattened out. SKIMMING SONG pressed the pace to the outside but weakened after the pole and dropped back. DYNAMIC FORCE dropped back early, raced evenly to the outside and was never a factor. IOTABGRAY lacked speed and trailed. SPECIAL GREY GHOST lacked early speed, raced three wide, and raced evenly in the backstretch
