LEGEND FORTYNINE vied for the lead received it in the first turn, opened up at the half and was much the best. OLD TOP HAT vied for the lead, took a hold to tuck in behind the leader, stayed on the rail to stalk, lost ground to leader in the last turn and was second best. SECOND HAND NEWS trailed early, not far off the pace, lost ground in the backstretch, made a wide move just after the half, went four wide at the head of the stretch. ARTIE'S BROTHER broke out, vied for the lead, stalked from the outside, weakened after the half held on for a small prize. GOLD FOR FREE was up close early, move in behind the leader, lost lengths, weakened at the quarter pole and gave way.
