**Footnotes**

BRAETTA was slow early, advance steadily along the backstretch, rallied three wide in the stretch and closed steadily. SOCORRO COUNTY was slow early, advance steadily along the backstretch, rallied four wide in the upper stretch and closed to get up for the place. ICE GIRL stalked ICE GIRL on the rail, bid for the lead in the backstretch, dueled, opened a short lead in the upper stretch but weakened in the late stretch. BANJO BABE raced close to the lead on the rail, made a bid in the third turn, rallied in the upper stretch but faded in the late going. S. L. CHARMER was slow early, entered the second turn three wide, gained steadily in the third turn and ran evenly in the stretch. CERTAINLY REGAL broke sharply, set the pace, dueled from the backstretch but weakened in the third turn and tired in the stretch. KATHERN'S CAT saved ground, raced evenly, weakened along the backstretch and dropped back. TO DREAM AGAIN was three wide early, stalked the pace, weakened along the backstretch and gave way in the stretch.
