Footnotes

NORTHERN ACCENT stalked the pace on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and closed. THINKIN POSITIVE dueled on the rail but weakened in the stretch but prevailed for place. EYE SCAREY dueled to the outside, weakened in the stretch but was outfinished for place. FERION SKY saved ground, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. LITTLE TRAPPER saved ground, raced evenly, altered course to the outside in mid stretch, rallied and gained ground late. TRUST IN JO stalked the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. REMOVE raced close up early but was taken back, drifted out entering the first turn, raced evenly and was no threat. GAP OF DUNLOE raced wide early, moved to the rail in the backstretch, raced evenly and was no factor. ASHWICK lacked speed and was no factor.
