**Footnotes**

BRIARTIC BABE dueled on the rail, drew clear in the second turn, weakened in the stretch and just lasted. MISS REGAL ROSE raced evenly on the rail, gained steadily on the rail, closed fast and just missed. BETTER THAN JIF saved ground but dropped back early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide and gained ground. ALL THE RIGHTNOTES dueled to the outside of BRIARTIC BABE but weakened after the quarter pole and flattened out in the stretch. CRAFTY NAVAL raced three wide early, ran evenly then rallied three wide in the upper stretch and gained ground. WELL REGARDED was slow early, trailed then rallied into the upper stretch and finished well. ESTEEM'S SPIRIT broke out start, raced three wide into the first turn, chased the lead but weakened in the second turn and faded. PICOLIT was slow early, raced evenly on the rail and was no threat. SHESASINGER was forced out at the start, raced three wide in the first turn, pressed the pace but weakened in the backstretch and tired. PRAIRIE AIRE raced evenly, dropped back in the backstretch and trailed.
