Footnotes

NOTSOSWEET raced close up on the rail, made a bid in the second turn, dueled and drew clear in mid stretch. WIRED TWO TWENTY set a pressured pace, dueled when challenged in the second turn, was in tight in the upper stretch and lost ground. The rider on WIRED TWO TWENTY claimed foul on NOTSOSWEET for interference in the upper stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed. VINNIE BARBERENO raced evenly on the rail, rallied into the upper stretch and finished well. AIRO FAITH broke sharply, stalked the pace, raced evenly but flattened out in the stretch. VINDGARI saved ground, raced evenly but weakened in the second turn and dropped back. THAT'S A GOOD BOY was slow early and passed tiring rivals. ISLAND DRUMS lacked speed, raced to thr outside and gave way. COMMANDING ACE contended to the outside but weakened in the backstretch and dropped back.
