SCOTIA'S MYST raced on the rail evenly with a steady gain, rallied in the upper stretch and closed steadily. MAGIC FLUTE chased the leaders was gaining then flattened out in the stretch. FLATTER US set the pace, drew clear in the backstretch but faded in the stretch. MARIA FORTUNATA broke well, saved ground then dropped back early. SILVERHAVEN raced wide early,dropped back, trailed and rallied passing tiring rivals. DARK DOUBLE raced three wide early weakened then dropped back. HIGHLAND HANNA was three wide early, stalked but dropped back in the backstretch. I'M SUNSATIONAL saved ground raced evenly and faded. LAINE AND CHASE no speed, no factor.
