FAMEQUEST saved ground, dueled with two rivals early then with just with ROWDY RENEGADE to the three quarters and held on. BILLYREA took back, gradual gain, was two wide in the last turn, edged over to rally down the stretch. KISS ME GOODBYE was in the middle of the track in the stretch the first time, kept even on the outside, was three wide in the last turn and closed well. TURF ELITE trailed early, still trailed at the half, slowly gained, went four wide at the head of the stretch and gained late. WE TAUGHT ED saved ground, raced mid pack, held position was even through out. ROWDY RENEGADE was five wide in the first turn, raced mid pack, was three wide in the second turn still wide around a tired horse late. KICKEN WEST chose the two path, dueled with two rivals, weakened at the three quarters and faded back. IRISH TWIST pushed to the front, was three wide in a duel with two competitors, took in behind the in the second turn and started to fade just before the three quarters.
