Footnotes

TEASE THE TIGER pressed the early pace, made a bid in the backstretch, dueled, opened a lead in the upper stretch. ROJO RED set the early pace on the rail, dueled in the backstretch, weakened in the upper stretch and held place. WILD YOUNG COWBOY was slow early, advanced steadily on the rail, rallied into the stretch and gained ground late. SMART CALL was three wide into the first turn, raced evenly to the outside, rallied four wide into the stretch and gained ground. REGAL CHIMERA chased the leaders on the rail, weakened in the second turn and faded. CHALKONEUP drifted out a bit entering the first turn, chased the leaders to the outside but weakened and dropped back in the second turn. MOOSE LAKE was off slowly, trailed and was no factor. HI LINE EXPRESS saved ground, raced evenly but dropped back steadily.
