PROUD RUNNER set a pressured pace on the rail, dueled in the second turn, rallied and drew off in the stretch. Q MAGIC raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the second turn then rallied into the stretch and finished second best. BROOKIE BABY was taken back early, stalked the pace from three wide, gained ground in the second turn but faded in the stretch. DOUBLE MI TROUBLE lacked early speed, gained ground along the rail, rallied three wide into the stretch and finished well. NEEDLESTICK pressed the pace to the outside but weakened late in the second turn and dropped back. WILA MICH I saved ground, raced evenly but faded. DESPERATELYDANDY lacked early speed, saved ground and passed tiring rivals. FRIEDA'S GIRL raced evenly to the outside but weakened in the second turn and dropped back. SUNDAY SUGAR saved ground, raced evenly and was never a factor.
