Footnotes

RATTLE THE CAGE raced three wide in the first turn, stalked the leaders made a bid at the quarter, dueled in the stretch and prevailed. SLEWEY showed no speed, raced evenly with a steady advance, rallied three wide and closed fast. BIG STEP set the pace on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished. GREAT GRIFFIN saved ground along the rail, raced evenly, gained in the second turn then flattened out in the stretch. SEVEN DIMES had no speed raced on the rail then rallied three wide. SKID was slow early, saved ground on the rail, gained in the second turn racing evenly down the stretch. DOUBLESEVEN was three wide in the first turn, raced close up, but weakened in the backstretch. JUKEBOX JACK saved ground, raced evenly, was not a factor. SIBERIAN SLEWPY was through early and trailed. EY SEE DEE SEE was three wide in the first turn, stalked, then weakened down the backstretch and faded.
