Footnotes

SALTY TART vied for the lead from three wide, dueled in the second turn, rallied and held well. FORWARD NOTIS saved ground, raced evenly, rallied four wide in the upper stretch and finished well. I LOST MY HALO vied for the lead from between rivals, dropped back a bit in the backstretch, came again, rallied three wide but flattened out. SMART N SEXY lacked speed, raced to the outside, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and gained ground. HIGHLY EXPLOSIVE was slow early, raced evenly, rallied five wide into the stretch and gained ground. SUNDAY SUGAR raced evenly to the outside, faded in the stretch. SILKY SALLY was slow early, raced evenly and passed tiring rivals. CLOSING TIME stalked the pace on the rail but weakened in the second turn and faded stretch. LUCK OF A LADY vied for the lead on the rail, weakened in the second turn, gave way in the stretch and was eased.
