BEAR'S HONEY broke sharply, dueled on the rail, opened a lead entering the second turn and drew clear. FUSION WELD raced three wide into the first turn, raced evenly, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied into the stretch and finished second best. GLAD'S AND ROSE'S stalked the lead to the outside, raced evenly but weakened in the second turn and flattened in the stretch. THAT YOU MISS BUE raced evenly from between rivals, weakened in the second turn and finished evenly. CLASSIC CONNECTION saved ground, raced evenly but weakened in the second turn and raced evenly in the stretch. VIZUALLY dueled to the outside, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. BEAR NOBILITY saved ground, raced evenly and was never a factor. FINE BY ME was slow early, trailed. KELLYS GUEST lacked speed, showed little.
