Footnotes

CANDID REMARK saved ground, raced evenly, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and closed well to get up late. BEAU BRASS was three wide early, pressed the pace, made a bid in the upper stretch, opened a lead in the stretch but just failed. CHURCHBRIDGE saved ground, raced evenly, rallied five wide in the upper stretch and gained. ALABAMA RAIN stalked the lead to the outside, bid three wide along the backstretch but weakened in the third turn and faded in the stretch. FRONTIER EXPRESS set a pressured pace on the rail but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. LITTLE GRIZZ was slow early, raced evenly and was no factor. FOREVER RASCAL was slow early, raced evenly to the outside, and was not a factor. CATALONE was taken back early to stalked the pace on the rail but weakened along the backstretch and tired.
