VICTORY ROMANCE stalked the lead to the outside, made a bid along the backstretch, pressed the pace, dueled in the stretch and prevailed. BEARS ARTISTE set the pace, rallied in the upper stretch, dueled but was outfinished. HEIDI'S ROSETTE was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide in the stretch and gained ground late. SPICY CANDY saved ground, raced close up, dropped back in the second turn and gained ground late. SMART N SEXY stalked the lead on the rail, dropped back in the second turn and faded in the stretch. MISS EMILY was off slowly, raced to the outside, dropped back in the second turn and gave way.
