Footnotes

WILD YOUNG COWBOY raced three wide early, ran evenly, bid four wide in the third turn, dueled in the stretch with BIG CHEESE and prevailed in a hard drive. BIG CHEESE stalked the pace on the rail, got through on the rail late in the backstretch, bid, dueled in the stretch but was outfinished. PERFECTIIONISM was slow early, gained ground to the outside, rallied in the upper stretch and closed late. CRAFTY BREW lacked speed, raced evenly on the rail, gained in the third turn and showed a mild rally. BIG GEORGE broke sharply, dueled to the outside but weakened after the quarter pole and finished evenly stretch. START THE CAR rail, evenly, gaining backstretch, blocked, lost ground, faded. TROUBLEONTHEBENCH saved ground. ALL FOR TOTTI stalked the early pace to the outside, bid three wide in the third turn and dropped back. RUNNING CHEWS dueled to the inside of BIG GEORGE but weakened in the third turn and dropped back.
