NEECHI'S REGAL SON chased the pace on the rail, gained ground in the backstretch, bid three wide into the stretch and prevailed. WEE BILLIE WILDE raced evenly on the rail, rallied three wide into the upper stretch and finished well. SIBERIAN SLEWPTY set a pressured pace on the rail, rallied but weakened in mid stretch and faded. TIMEFRAME hesitated at the start and trailed early, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and finished well. VALIANT VIC rushed to contend, pressed the pace to the outside, rallied into the stretch but weakened in mid stretch and faded. The rider on VALIANT VIC claimed foul on NEECHI'S REGAL SON for interference in the upper stretch, The claim of foul was not allowed. REESE PAK raced evenly from between rivals, failed to rally and faded in the stretch. MARKED APPEAL raced three wide into the first turn, continued evenly to the outside, entered the stretch four wide but was no threat. NIC'S ECHO raced evenly to the outside, dropped back steadily and trailed.
