ALAMEDA SLIM raced three wide early, ran evenly, got through on the rail in the upper stretch and closed steadily. CRIMINAL OFFENSE raced three wide into the first turn, set a pressured pace, rallied into the stretch but was outfinished. PART PIRATE saved ground, pressed the pace, made a bid at the quarter pole, rallied into the stretch but flattened out. RUNNING IRON stalked the pace to the outside, rallied wide into the stretch and finished evenly. PROJECT FIFTY FIVE lacked speed, saved ground, rallied three wide and gained ground. GENERAL GABE had no speed, trailed and showed a mild rally. EXPLORATION raced close up from between rivals, up weakened in the backstretch and finished evenly. KOOL ATLANTIC raced evenly on the rail, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. PERFECTO CAT lost the rider at the start.
