Footnotes

BOADINI stalked the pace to the outside, bid three wide in the backstretch, led in the upper stretch and drew clear. PLAGIARIST was carried out in the first turn, raced evenly, gained ground steadily, rallied four wide and closed. JUST CALL ME DUKE was slow early, raced evenly, gained steadily rallied four wide and finished well. LUCKY THIRTEEN dueled to the outside, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. MILLWRIGHT stalked the pace from between rivals, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. VISION OF ROSES saved ground, stalked the pace, ran evenly but weakened in the second turn and faded. MOSSBANK dueled on the rail, weakened in the second turn and dropped back. ITSWHATWELIVEFORE drifted entering the first turn, raced evenly to the outside but tired and dropped back. PROSPECT BEGONIA lacked speed, trailed and was never a factor.
