MIDTOWN BULLET stalked the pace to the outside, bid three wide late in the backstretch, vied for the lead but opened a lead in the upper stretch and finished well. SALT FLAT SPEED stalked on the rail, bid and vied in the second turn, weakened in the upper stretch and held place. SMILE N WAVE raced evenly to the outside, chased the leaders, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and closed the gap. MR. SHADAR bobbed at the start, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and finished evenly. HEAVENLY CHORUS was slow early, saved ground and showed a mild rally. COOL KAHUNA raced evenly on the rail, dropped back in the backstretch and trailed. TINY GIANT vied on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and gave way.
